Dear Guest,

Australian wine has conquered our hearts and mouths, and has filled our glasses more every year since the 1980's. This has been made possible for a number of reasons.

In the '80's and '90's, Australian winemakers travelled the world and asked the consumer: "What do you want to drink?". The reply was simple: "We want to drink round, subtle wines, not too dry or tannic, and with a great price/quality ratio. And we want to understand what we drink, with or without food."

And so it was done. Australian wines that came on the market in Europe were recognisable in flavour and grape variety, but not in the origin of the wine.

Since then, a lot has changed.

Australian wine evolved on its own, not comparing itself with the classic countries like France. Australians are believers of terroir, but interpreted it differently.

For them the style of wine expresses the fusion of nature, the viticulturist and the winemaker. This resulted in a new and far wider choice of wines from different regions and grape varieties. The focus became: making pure wines, using modern techniques, true to varietal and using less oak.

Now, Australian wines are incredibly diverse, as is its food.

Matching Australian wines with Australian food is a pleasure, and not something new but a constantly evolving process.

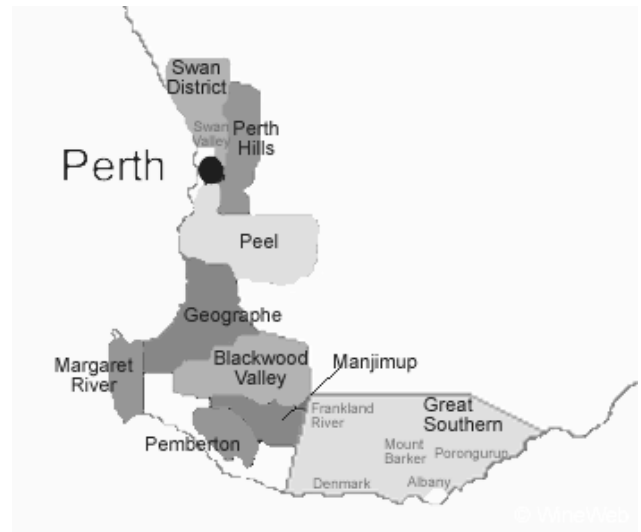

Although grapes are grown in all Australia's states and territories, the wine regions hug the south-eastern corner and the south-western tip of Australia's vast coastline and line two of the great river systems, the Mur-rumbidgee and the Murray. The main regions fall, for the most part, within the boundaries of five states:

Western Australia

Western Australia has some of the newest wine areas in the country-clustered in the south-west corner of the state, not far from the city of Perth - in a very climatically varied region. Renowned are the Margaret River Chardonnay and Cabernet Sauvignon.

South Australia

South Australia is the most important state, producing the most quantity. Every region has its own unique aspects; The influence of the nearby sea in the Adelaide Hills and McLaren Vale, the glowing hills of Clare Valley, the warm and dry summers in Barossa Valley and the red soils in Coonawarra. Wines are from zesty fresh Sauvignon Blanc through to rich, ripe Shiraz and Cabernet.

Victoria

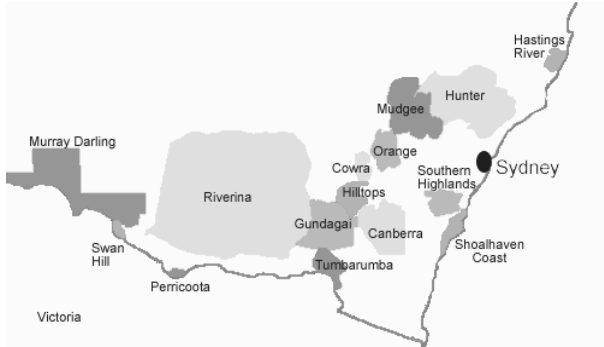
Victoria, the most southerly mainland state, produces an enormous variety of wines and has the most number of producers. Most regions are cool climate which results in fresh and lighter style wines.



New South Wales

New South Wales is the oldest and, climatically, the hottest wine-producing state, and includes the famous Hunter River Valley north of the capital, Sydney.

Tasmania

The whole island of Tasmania is an official wine zone. There are no wine regions. However, there is a broad division between Northern Tasmania and Southern Tasmania and within this division there are distinct viticultural areas. The island has a range of microclimates and soil types which gives Tasmanian wines their diversity of character.
